

Kingdom Kids Ministry Opportunities

The positions for classroom assistance that are currently being filled within Kingdom Kids and their descriptions are:

1. Class Room Overseer:

- Works closely with Coordinator.
- Is responsible for overseeing all Kingdom Kids classes for that particular church service.
- Makes sure the classes run smoothly, fielding any specific issues with children or staffing.
- Works directly with teachers to assist them.

2. Lead Teacher:

- Works closely with the Coordinator/Overseer to provide a structured program of teaching and ministry to the children in the classroom.
- Oversees and provides for the physical care of the children.
- Is the decision maker in the classroom.

3. Assistant Teacher:

- Assists the Lead Teacher in their responsibilities.
- Is able to substitute for the Team Leader.
- Provides for the physical care of the children. Oversees sign-in.
- Assists with distractions during specific teaching times.

4. Junior Teacher:

- Responsible sixth grade or older student who assists with any of the above responsibilities.

5. Special Event Volunteers:

- Is on the Special Event contact list and is called when the church has a Special Event that needs childcare.

6. Substitute Teachers:

- Is on the Sunday School Substitute List and is called when a regular teacher needs a replacement for a specific day and class.

We know that not everyone is able to help with hands on, consistently scheduled classroom time. There are many other ways you can support Kingdom Kids:

Classroom Maintenance/Coordination:

Is responsible to maintain, organize and coordinate all Kingdom Kids classrooms a couple times per month. Keeps all cabinets organized, toys cleaned

Administrative Tasks Assistant:

Assists the Kingdom Kids Coordinator with miscellaneous administrative tasks.

Curriculum Management/Coordination:

Is responsible to keep track of the Kingdom Kids curriculum, ordering new curriculum, and ordering missing pieces to the current curriculum.

Volunteer Pathway

1. Application

- Read the manual
- Meet with Coordinator for specific class training
- Be in real-time class situations as a trainee
